MONITORING COMMITTEE VISIT

Karachi, Friday the 07th of September, 2018: The Monitoring Committee of the Board of Directors of Karachi Infrastructure Development Co. Ltd. (KIDCL), headed by Lt. Gen. Retd. Shahid Niaz along with Federal Secretary Finance Mr. Arif Ahmed Khan and Secretary, Ministry of Communications Mr. Shoaib Ahmed Siddiqui visited Green Line BRTS and schemes under Karachi Package to study and discuss the progress of Karachi's first-ever BRTS and other works.

The team visited the entire Corridor of the Green Line, starting with the All-BRTS-Line Integration point where the underpass is under construction. The Consultant heads of Green Line and Karachi Package briefed the members on-site about the detailed design of Numaish Underpass and works under Karachi Package

Following the spirit of Federal Government, "**Plant for Pakistan**", the team members planted tree saplings to kick start the national plantation drive (Pictures attached).

Infrastructure component of Main Corridor from Surjani up to Guru Mandir (22 Kms - Phase-IA) is complete in all aspects and construction/fabrication of 21 out of total 25 station is in final stages and will be completed in all aspect in the first half of the Current Financial Year. The works executed under Karachi Package were also minutely checked by the team.

KIDCL Management ensured the team that Construction of state-of-the-art underground All BRTS Line Integration Terminal with Parking Facility and Commercial Mezzanine Floor will be completed in current Financial year.

The Committee showed satisfaction over the quality of work and stressed upon KIDCL management to complete the work of remaining Bus Stations without further delay. On Numaish Underpass, special care shall be taken to minimize public nuisance with proper and effective traffic diversion plan. Secretary Communications also directed KIDCL to complete works under Karachi Package in the Current Financial Year.
